our skills and, above all, our sympathy and understanding. It is up to you in the colleges you represent to recognize these challenges and to take advantage of the opportunity that is now ours.”

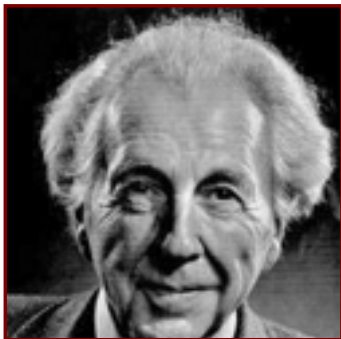
With Leonard Bernstein conducting Jack Benny plays the violin at Carnegie Hall. “He came, he sawed, he conquered,” said a Boston critic.

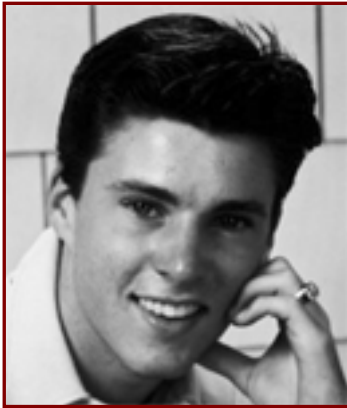
